The Greg Ulmer Theatre Scholarship is part of the GISH Theatre Boosters annual scholarship program. Mr. Ulmer, or “GU” as they called him, taught theatre at Grand Island Senior High for 29 years. He retired in 2021. The scholarship is designed to recognize an outstanding theatre student.

Amount and Terms

- \$500 x 1 year

Number of Scholarships

- 1

Eligibility

- Must be a graduate of Grand Island Senior High School
- Must be active in theater performances
- Must be pursuing a 2 or 4-year degree at an accredited college university or trade school.

- Write a personal statement on why you are applying for this scholarship. (Max 500 words)

Selection Procedure

Applications will be reviewed by a scholarship selection committee appointed by the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation.

Terms of Payment

The scholarship will be paid through the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation to appropriate educational institution per scholarship eligibility defined above. Scholarships larger than \$500 will be split into equal semester payments. The student must provide proof of enrollment (class schedule) and student number to the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation for scholarship distribution. Proof of enrollment is needed for each semester covered by scholarship terms.
