Read guidelines to see which scholarships you qualify for.

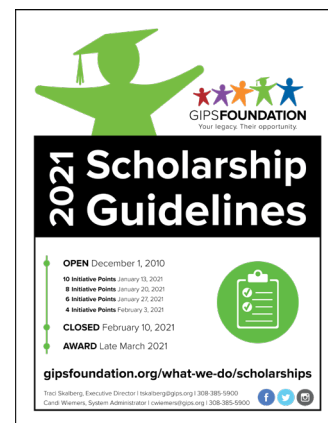
- Check to see if references are complete.
