- Must be a first generation college student
- Must be pursuing a medical degree including the following: nutrition, physical therapy, dentistry, pre-medicine, pre-pharmacy, chiropractic, nursing
- Must be of Hispanic or Latino/a origin
- Preference will be given to students who demonstrate financial need

#### Selection Procedure

Applications will be reviewed by a scholarship selection committee appointed by the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation.

#### Terms of Payment

Scholarships larger than \$500 will be split into equal semester payments. The student must provide proof of enrollment (class schedule) and student number to the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation for scholarship distribution.
