Grand Island Senior High, Grand Island Central Catholic, Grand Island Northwest, Heartland Lutheran
- Must be involved in music or musical performance in school and/or the community
- Student must be attending the University of Nebraska at Kearney and continue to have involvement in any music program, vocal or instrumental
- Music major or minor is not required

Essay Questions

- Give a brief synopsis of your involvement in school and community music activities. (Max 500 words)
- What are your dreams for using your talent in music 10 years from now? Tell us how you plan to continue to develop your interest and talent. (Max 500 words)

Selection Procedure

Applications will be reviewed by a scholarship selection committee appointed by the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation.

Terms of Payment

The scholarship will be paid through the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation to appropriate educational institution per scholarship eligibility defined above. Scholarships larger than \$500 will be split into equal semester payments. The student must provide proof of enrollment (class schedule) and student number to the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation for scholarship distribution. Proof of enrollment is needed for each semester covered by scholarship terms.
