Charles and Bessie Frith have created this annual scholarship for deserving young men and women who are graduates of Grand Island Senior High School. The scholarship is intended for students who are hardworking and need the additional support to realize their college ambitions.

## **Amount and Terms**

- \$10,000 x 4 years

## **Number of Scholarships**

- 2

## **Eligibility**

- Must be a graduate of Grand Island Senior High
- Must demonstrate financial need by qualifying for the free or reduced school lunch program
- Must have the ability to succeed in college, however, an honor roll grade point average is not necessary. A 2.0 or 3.0 grade point average is acceptable
- Must demonstrate ability to work hard for desired goals
- Must demonstrate good character and citizenship
- Must attend a public Nebraska trade school or University. Examples: Central Community College, Southeast Community College, University of Nebraska, Peru State College, Wayne State College, etc.

Applications will be reviewed by a scholarship selection committee appointed by the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation.

## **Terms of Payment**

The scholarship will be paid through the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation to appropriate educational institution per scholarship eligibility defined above. Scholarships larger than \$500 will be split into equal semester payments. The student must provide proof of enrollment (class schedule) and student number to the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation for scholarship distribution. Proof of enrollment is needed for each semester covered by scholarship terms.
