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- **Icons:** Icons next to form name indicate the status of the form. (green checkmark, yellow triangle, and the red exclamation point)
- **Save Diskette:** You must click on the blue save diskette to save any changes made to the form. If you have not saved information entered into a field a warning box will display to give you a chance to save the new information.
- **Form Name in Bold:** The current form selected and displayed will be highlighted in blue.

Form Descriptions

Contact Information: application agreement statements, address and contact information, is the applicant graduating from high school, and ethnicity

Education Information: elementary, middle, and high schools attended; class rank, class size, grade point average; ACT and SAT scores

Non-GISH Registrar: only to be completed by non-GISH students, generates system email requesting transcript

Household Information: parent contact information, household information, free or reduced lunch information

College Plans: college/university and acceptance status; if the college/university is in Nebraska; general major; specific major; general minor; specific minor; degree working towards

Work Experience: a work history listing employment, title, start and end dates, and hours

Extracurricular Activities: School Activities information including organization, number of years, currently active, offices held, and awards; School Sponsored Sports information including activity, number of years, letter winner and number of years, and if they are currently active; Community Activities/Awards information including organization, number of years, currently active, offices held, and awards; Teammates participant; AFJROTC participant; leadership essay; volunteer essay

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Personal Essays: personal narrative essay; career goals essay; and financial plan essay

Scholarship Essays: specific essay questions for specific scholarships, must be complete to be considered for specific scholarships, check guidelines for qualifications

References and Signature: name and email for references, system generates email request when page is saved

Academic Reference: a reference from a high school teacher who has personally taught the applicant that contains a score, a strength, a weakness, a character statement, and their teaching position

General Reference: this reference could be a teacher, coach, counselor, supervisor, or anyone from the community not related to the student; it contains the same information as the academic reference

Score Sheet: each review group has a score sheet, contains answer fields necessary to review and recommend for scholarships, applicants cannot view score sheet

College Students ONLY

College Information: full-time status, which high school graduated from, how many college credits completed, college currently attending, major and minor, college transcript upload, additional education information, essay questions

College References and Signature: name and email for references, system generates email request when page is saved
