

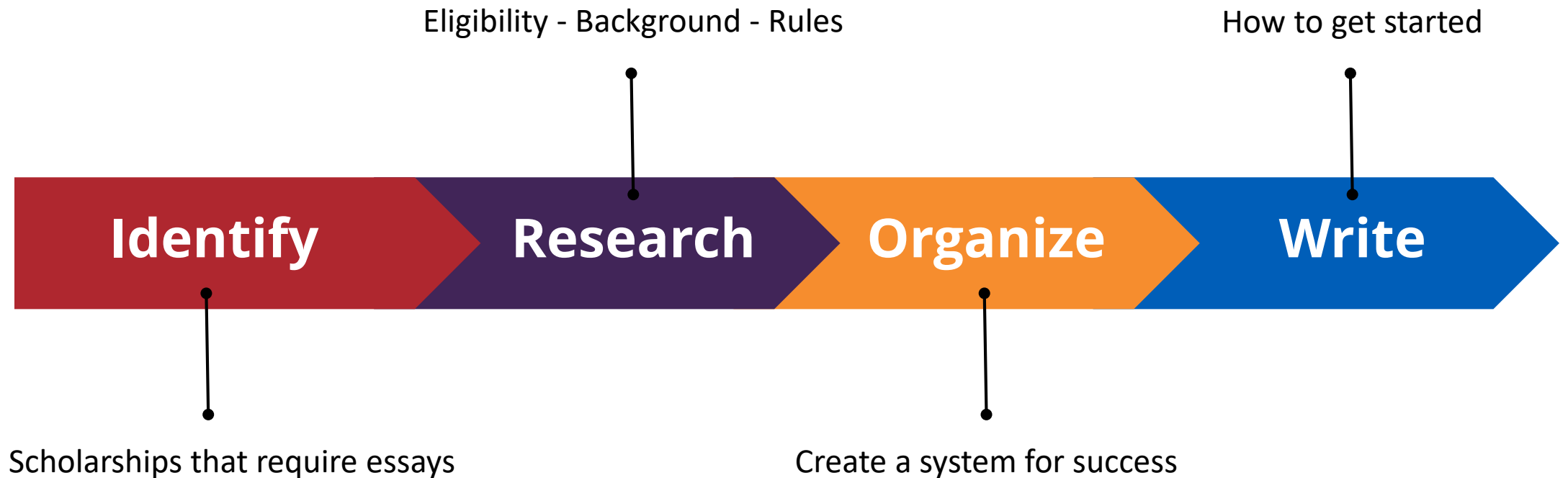

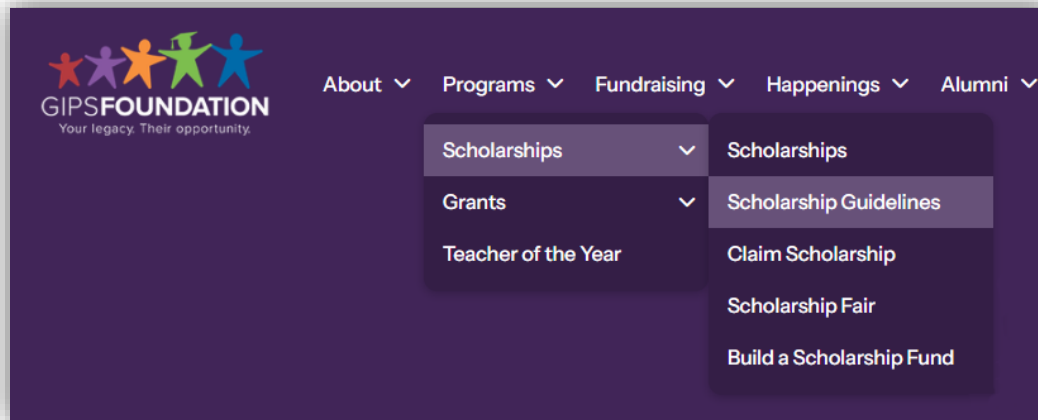

What are the “rules”?

- Is there a **word limit**?
- Can you use **your name** in the essay?
- Must complete the essay now to move on in the application? Or can you come back to it?

(Max 500 words)

DO NOT USE YOUR NAME IN THE ESSAYS. If you use your name, the Scholarship Committee reserves the right to disqualify your application.

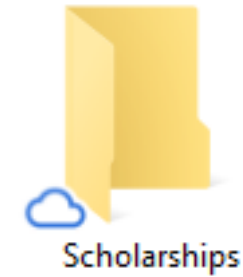
NOTE: Proof your essays before you submit your application. When you paste essays from other sources, some characters may not import correctly.

- Create a **Google folder** for scholarship information
- Create or update a **Resume**, save your **ACT Scores** and a **transcript**
- Create a **Scholarship Sheet**

Organize

Create a system for success

Essay Doc example

Get organized

- Think about who will be your **references** and ask them early
- Save **essays as individual documents**
 - ✓ Include essay prompt and “rules”
 - ✓ Easy to share to get feedback
 - ✓ Can use as a starting point for future essays
- Create **calendar reminders**
- Share with someone who will help keep you on track

Scholarship Essay Strategies

Kaufmann-Cummings Trust Scholarship

Scholarship Essay Required

The Directors of the Kaufmann-Cummings Foundation offer 6 four-year scholarships for \$1,000 per year to Grand Island Senior High students.

Eligibility

- Must be a graduate of Grand Island Senior High
- Must rank in the top ¼ of class
- Must have attended Grand Island Senior High for three years
- Must have demonstrated regular attendance and good conduct

Make it unique

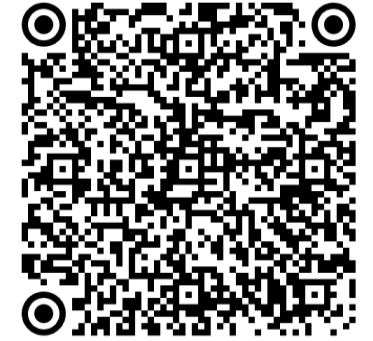
- Be personal. Be **YOU**.

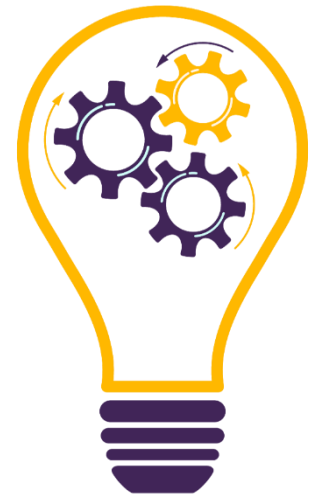

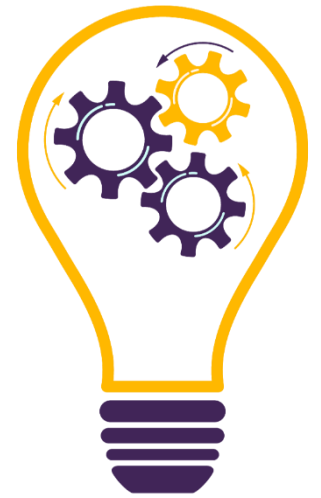

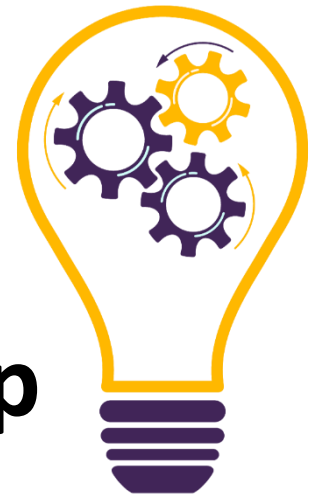

How to get started



A good essay answers the question.

A *great essay* takes it further.

- What adversity have you had to overcome? (*past* experience)
- How has it transformed you? (who you are *now*)
- How will you use this experience/transformation to succeed in college and career? (take it *further*)



Think of the **Personal Narrative** as your origin story. Expand on this story in subsequent essays.

Tell us about you.

The best personal statements describe strengths and achievements in an intimate and unique way, capitalizing on life experiences which have molded you into a worthy candidate.
Let the selection committee know who you are through your writing. (Max 500 words)
