Selection Procedure

Applications will be reviewed by a scholarship selection committee appointed by the Grand Island Public Schools Foundation.

Terms of Payment

The scholarship will be paid through the GIPS Foundation to appropriate educational institution per scholarship eligibility defined above. Scholarships larger than \$500 will be split into equal semester payments.

Claim Scholarship

The student must provide proof of enrollment (class schedule) and student ID number to the GIPS Foundation for scholarship distribution. Proof of enrollment is needed for each semester covered by scholarship terms. Bob Hamblet Northwestern University Scholarship

Eligibility:

* Must be a graduate of Grand Island Senior Highand attended Grand Island Senior High for at least two years * Well-rounded candidates with demonstrated academic, athletic, performing arts or community service accomplishments * Need to be admitted to Northwestern through the normal admittance procedures * Must upload Northwestern financial aid estimate

* An ideal candidate would be one for whom Northwestern University is his/her dream school and financial considerations are a barrier to attendance

NOTE: To be considered for this scholarship your application MUST be submitted on or before January 15, 2025

Eligibility




