# Create a system for success

## Essay Doc example

# **Get organized**

- Think about who will be your references and ask them early
- Save essays as individual documents
  - ✓ Include essay prompt and "rules"
  - ✓ Easy to share to get feedback
  - ✓ Can use as a starting point for future essays
- Create calendar reminders
- Share with someone who will help keep you on track

### Kaufmann-Cummings Trust Scholarship

#### Scholarship Essay Required

The Directors of the Kaufmann-Cummings Foundation offer 6 four-year scholarships for \$1,000 per year to Grand Island Senior High students.

#### Eligibilit

- Must be a graduate of Grand Island Senior High
- Must rank in the top ½ of class
- . Must have attended Grand Island Senior High for three years
- Must have demonstrated regular attendance and good conduct

# How to get started

# Read the essay prompt

- Think about the question
- Be aware of your audience

Reviewer examples: donors, board members, educators, community members

# Make it unique

- Be personal. Be YOU.
- Don't be tempted to use the same essay over, and over, and over...





What you write is more important than how you write.

# How to get started



A good essay answers the question.

A great essay takes it further.

- What adversity have you had to overcome? (past experience)
- How has it transformed you? (who you are now)
- How will you use this experience/transformation to succeed in college and career? (take it further)






Think of the Personal Narrative as your origin story. Expand on this story in subsequent essays.
