
#### **Where Donations Come From**

\$418,018 awarded to 99 Class of 2024 students. Since 2013, \$188,615 has been granted for dual-credits since 2013. Our scholarship receptions provide a meaningful opportunity for students and donors to connect, encourage, and discuss their life ambitions. The impact of these donors is truly transformative.

#### **Let Your Creativity Glow**

Shoemaker Elementary kindergarten through fifth-grade students created a magical display this year (2024), transforming their school into an underwater utopia. Families were spellbound as they entered a world illuminated by seaweed, jellyfish, and scuba divers, their glow-in-the-dark creations casting a dramatic light from floor to ceiling.

The "Let Your Creativity Glow" project, a dazzling display of imagination, was funded by a Classroom Grant given by the GIPS Foundation. Working with these luminous materials was a challenge for many students, but ultimately unlocked a creativity they never knew they possessed.

The Foundation's support allows students to express themselves with a newfound confidence and joy. "We witnessed a remarkable transformation," shared Rhonda Riha, a Social Emotional Creative Arts teacher. "We went from 'I can't do this', to 'I'm going to try this out' and, 'Look what I just created!'"

#### **Starr Stallion Sharing Stable**

At Starr Elementary's 2024 fall parent-teacher conferences, families had a chance to pick out items from the Stallion Sharing Stable, a free sharing closet created in 2023 with the help of a Grand Island Public Schools Foundation Classroom Grant.

Nicki Nesvara, Starr Elementary School Social Worker, applied for the grant and received funding in fall 2023. The Stallion Sharing Stable offers basic necessities such as clothing, hygiene products, food items, and school supplies. By alleviating basic needs, the project aims to improve the overall educational experience and students' social-emotional learning and wellbeing.



#### Generosity of our staff is inspiring, unwavering, and extraordinary

Our Staff Giving Campaign raised over \$91,000, demonstrating the dedication and commitment of our staff to our students' success. A significant highlight of the 2024 campaign was the heartfelt gesture from Cheryl and Douglas Jensen, who provided a \$5,000 challenge gift.

Walnut Middle School was awarded a Classroom Grant from the GIPS Foundation in the fall of 2023 to purchase new fitness equipment for the Junior Islander Power program. Eon Lemburg, former Social Studies teacher (current GISH Athletic Director) applied for the grant. He received more than \$2,300 to buy a trap bar, kettlebells, resistance bands, a slam ball, and a rowing machine to help students pursue a lifelong healthy lifestyle. With the addition of new and updated equipment, students will be able to learn and master different workouts that best suit their needs. This initiative is essential for fostering their overall well-being and success. All students in athletics, physical education, and health elective courses will use this equipment for years to come.

Eon Lemburg shared his thoughts on the grants offered by the GIPS Foundation: "Our kids deserve every opportunity regardless of price. The Foundation grants allow students to see that we are invested in them. That we are confident in their abilities and that we believe that every student is capable of success. The Foundation has been an extremely impactful organization that allows students the opportunity to be successful without fear of the financial cost."
